It is with great pleasure that I can confirm the dates of the next INEDITS Encounters that will take place in Porto Vecchio (Corsica) from 4th to 7th November 2010. Casa di Lume (Cinémathèque de Corse) will welcome INEDITS as we celebrate our 20th anniversary.

You will find attached the programme decided upon at our last Board meeting in June 2010. This year the main theme will be "MARE NOSTRUM – The Mediterranean seen by amateurs". This theme will be developed on Friday 5th November. On the same day, we will spend 90 minutes on the past twenty years of INEDITS, a good moment to observe the history of our association and take a look at its perspectives.

The workshop on Saturday 6th will be devoted to the technical aspects of our work, nowadays more and more complex. This time, it will be our technicians who will help out all through the day as we discuss and demonstrate the different digital techniques and machines we use in our archives. This workshop, divided into two parts, will comprise, firstly, a discussion on transfer methods and the experiences of different archives. In the afternoon, a practical workshop on Flashscan SD and Dixi will be open to a restricted number of people. The results of the day might bring food for thought to those taking decisions in terms of equipment and investment.

Public screenings are also planned. The first one on 4th November at 9pm will show a documentary film based on amateur films. It will refer to the main theme of our Encounters. We will inform you in September of the name of the author and the film that will have been selected. On Friday 5th, we will have a public screening with films proposed by INEDITS members, in accordance with the general theme "MARE NOSTRUM". Please take a close look at the presentation note here below to suggest materials that will be a surprise to the public and will show the diversity of viewpoints.

In addition to all of this we will have time to meet with each other, to exchange ideas and projects that will make our links stronger and keep stronger over the years.

These Encounters will end with our yearly General Assembly, an occasion to make a point on the future direction of our Association.

I wish you a beautiful summer, and remind you to respond before the deadlines with your registration and your hotel reservation.
